Installation of Inner Rails to Console

1. Remove rail/slide assembly from cushions.




2. Place rail assembly on flat surface and fully extend slide as shown in picture below.





3. With fully extend slide (picture 2), find the release latch and pull and remove inner rail



4. Take the 1U console out of packaging and lay on flat surface. The inner rail can go either on the left or right side of basepan with latch mechanism toward the rear of unit. Mounting locations can be easy identified by the notched plastic and the basepan is stamped with the letter "A".







 Place flat side of inner rail on side of basepan. Align holes with pan inserts marked "A". Thread 6-32 screws (qty 2) to hold rail to basepan. Note: Use 8-in/lb of torque to secure screw in place. <u>Front Mount</u>






Rear Mount



6. Repeat steps 2-5 for the other rail/slide assembly. The inner rail installation is complete.



7. To unlock and retract the rail/slide assembly from step 2, depress lever and secondary member is free to retract.



Note: Keep expose assembly free of debris while slide is apart! There is a light film of grease on ball bearing race, so limit touching mechanism.

Reference the 17.3 user manual to perform installation of rail assemblies and console to the rack.
